

AI - Student Use

AI is everywhere and can be a useful tool when used correctly. Students should use it as an additional skill.

Recommended Apps



Chat GPT is the most recognised. Helpful for generating questions and providing content.



Logic Balls creates revision guides on subjects and topics along with questions for students to test.



Gizmo is a flashcard creator, allowing students to digitally store and share with others.



Revisely is a platform for students to create flashcards and quizzes which can be shared with others.

Best Practise

1. **Prompts:** For many Ai tools, the quality of the response will depend on the quality of the prompt. Be very specific!
2. **Efficiency:** This removes potential procrastination in the form of choosing a study strategy, the topic and questions, allowing you to focus on retrieval.
3. **Storage:** Most Ai tools have their cloud system allowing students to save their resources. No more “my dog ate my revision!”.

Students should use AI as a supplementary revision resource – NOT to do the work for them!

Phone and revision

Phones are multi-functional tools that, when used **CORRECTLY**, can support students with revision.

Top tips

1. Set **alarms** to **notify** you of upcoming revision. Use a **timer** so you can take **breaks**.
2. Add your **revision** sessions to a **family calendar**, including staying after school.
3. **Camera** - not just for selfies. Take **pictures** of **classwork**, **test scores**, **diagrams** (ask permission first!)
4. **QR codes** - many revision guides have these which contain **useful sites** or **videos**.
5. **Recorder** - don't want to type or write? **Talk** your revision notes, creating your own **soundbites** to listen to whenever.



Best Practise

- **Disable notifications** from social media/distracting apps.
- **Download** any **media** to view **offline** or not use data.
- If **listening** to **music**, choose something **repetitive** or **ambient** instead of your favourite tunes.
- Before you start revising, **finish any conversations** so you are not waiting for a response.
- Create a **revision folder** on your phone to store your apps in one place.
- If you know the phone is **too much of a temptation**, hand it over or lock it away.

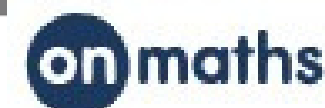
