What are Flash Cards?

- Flashcards are a study tool that engage what is known as 'active recall', the process of repetitively retrieving information from memory.
- Flashcards should:
 - Have a singular question on the front, with an answer on the back
 - Contain short bursts of information
 - Be made as soon as possible after learning something new.

Pro's and Con's of Flash Cards

Pro's	Con's
<ul style="list-style-type: none">Portable – allowing you to study on the goCreating them assists memory consolidationEncourage self-reflection when you check to see if you had the correct answerSupports dual coding if you combine pictures with words	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Too much information can overload the card and your working memory, making them ineffectiveCan mistakenly be used for summarising, rather than testingAdding lots of colours and images can make these time-consuming to create
