Contingency sessions

The exam timetable includes a contingency afternoon session – Wednesday 11 June and <u>has</u> been extended to include a contingency day Wednesday 25 June.

This allows flexibility for the exam boards in the event that should a significant, unexpected event arise nationally or locally during the exam period such that no students (or a large number of them) are unable to take an exam when planned. We hope that the contingency session and day will not be needed, but students should not make plans ahead of time which will prevent them being available throughout the exam timetable, including the contingency day, just in case any of their exams need to be rearranged by the exam boards. Once a student has completed all his/her exams there is no need to remain available, but any plans made before then are made at their own risk.

*<u>Clash exams</u>

Candidates sitting both Physical Education and Film Studies on Mon 19 May at 1.30pm will have one exam rescheduled on that day.

Any student that has a clash of exams must see the Examination Officer for an explanatory letter.

RESULTS DAY – THURSDAY 21 AUGUST 2025

The results from each of the GCSE Boards should arrive in school on 21 August 2025. Students may collect their results from school between 9.00am and 11.00am. Post Results/Appeals information will be enclosed with results. Members of Senior Leadership Team will be available to discuss results during this time. Any results not collected will be posted and should arrive the following week.

Examination Certificates are expected to arrive in school during late October and will be presented during the Year 11 Certificate Evening in late November or early December. Certificates not collected during certificate evening will be available for collection from School Reception after this event.
